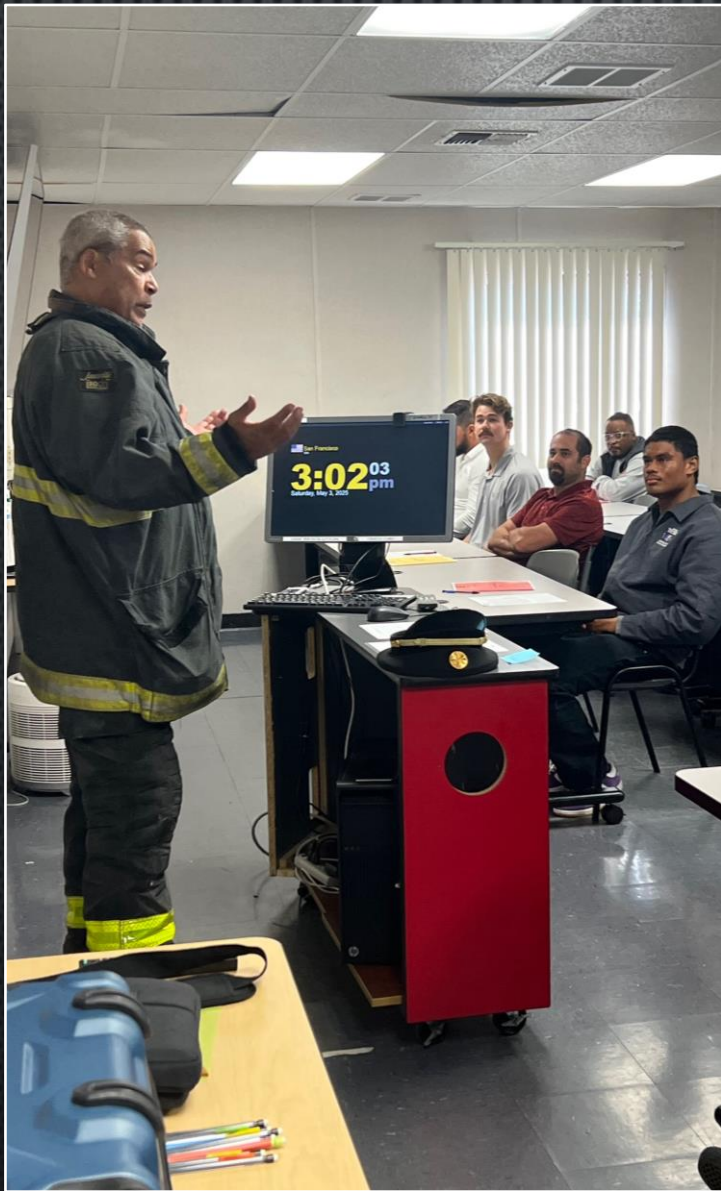

We will be receiving eleven (11) units.

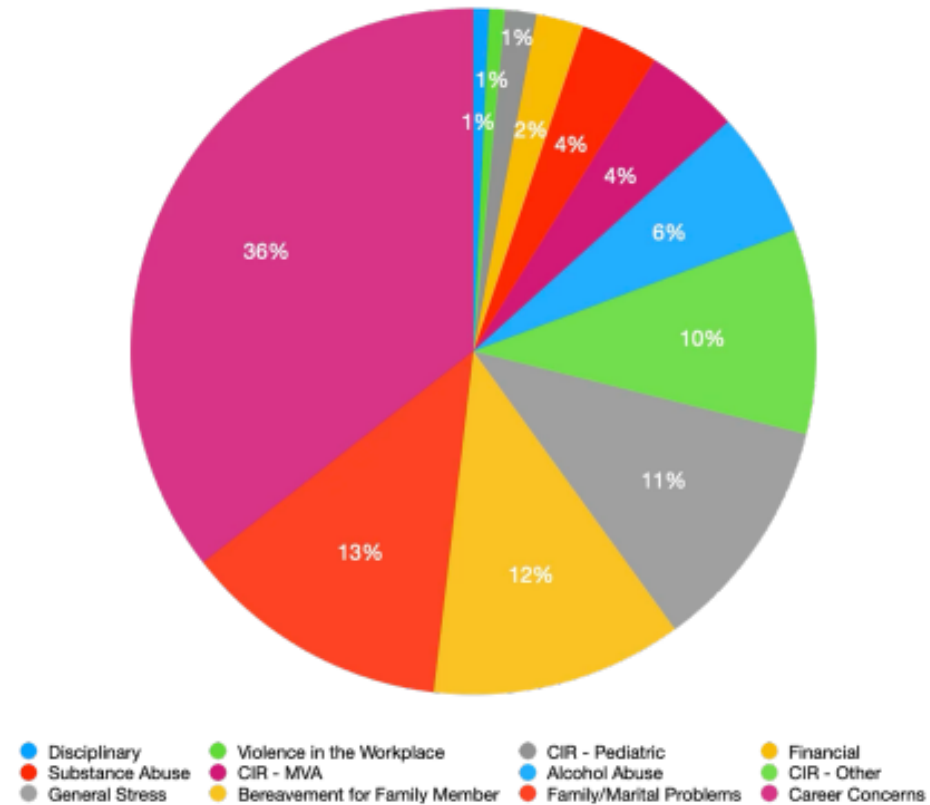

Background Investigations

- After completing thorough background investigations, 20 candidates began the EMS Academy (class 27/13) on May 5th.

ISB finished thirty-six (36) background investigations for the 136th H2 academy.

NEW SFFD DOT DEVELOPMENT

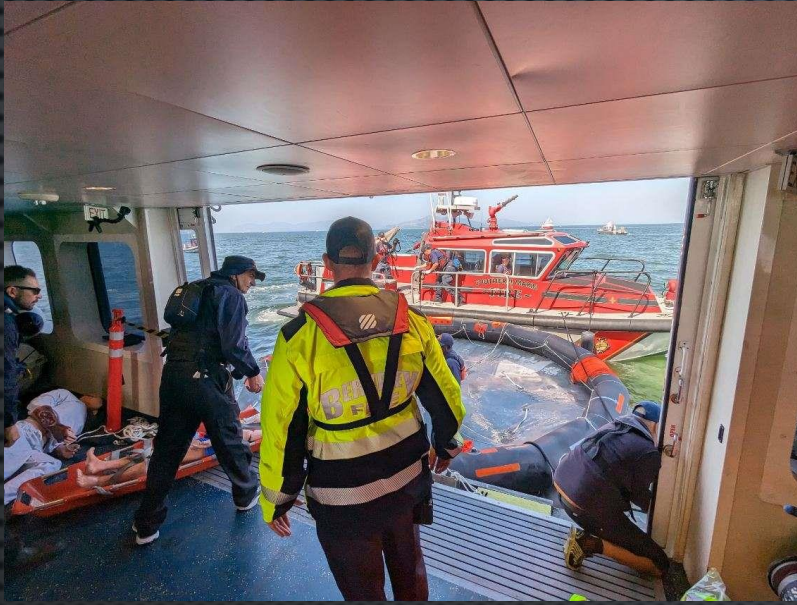


Design Development Rendering, DLR Group

- A public outreach presentation was delivered to the Bayview Hill Neighborhood Association by SFFD, Public Works Project Management, Bureau of Architecture and Bureau of Landscape Architecture and DLR Group the executive architect
- A constructability review of the DOT plans involving Swinerton Builders and the architecture and engineering teams occurred which resulted in valuable coordination
- Design meetings led to progress on the site lighting, technology, audio visual equipment, signage and further refinements of the training structures
- Public Works reports that actual spending on the project increased from \$13,741,193 to \$13,908,632.
