

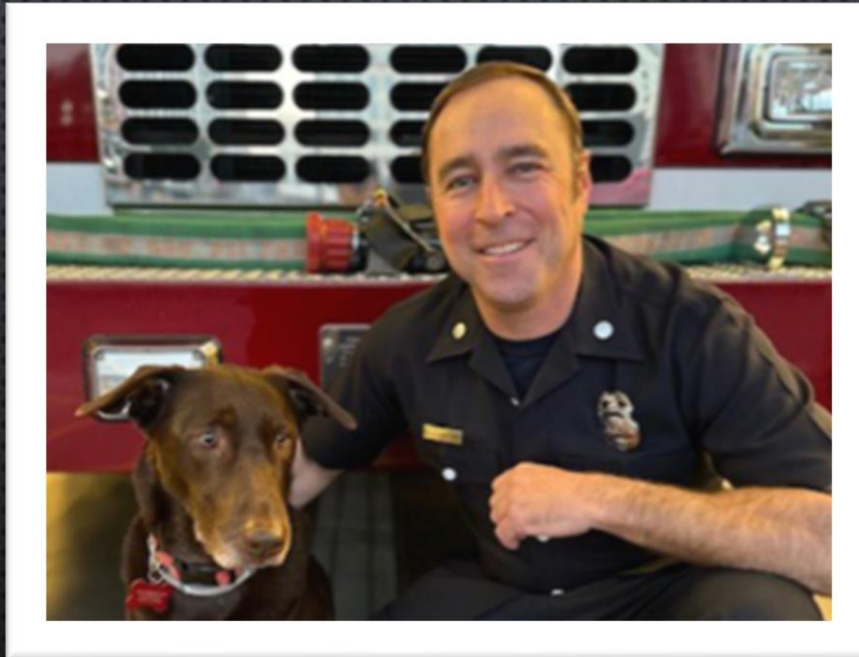


DEPUTY CHIEF OF ADMINISTRATION SAYUMI BRANNAN
